A Message from Your Management Company

Recently, we had the opportunity to partner with Avista to address the trees along Mission Ave., between Molter and Malvern. Avista, through its Tree Replacement Program, generously offered to remove the trees along Mission that show signs of decay, could be a hazard to the electric lines and are in generally declining health. The trees will be replaced with utility-friendly trees that won't grow to interfere with the electric lines. This will create a long-term benefit for our community, enhancing reliability of electric service and resulting in less ongoing pruning and maintenance. Avista will also install a beautification barrier around the electrical boxes and place a willow tree in the swale near the roundabout, which will assist with drainage issues and be a beautiful addition to the Association common area in years to come. Avista will be a long-term partner for several of the projects the Association is planning for the future. If you crews working in the area, please stay back and allow a safe distance.

Avista is always looking to partner with residential customers in the area as part of the Tree Replacement Program, to identify opportunities for removal and replacement with utility-friendly trees. If you are interested or have questions, you can call Avista at 1-800-227-9187.
