Subject: Vinyl Siding Uniformity

Section B, Subsection 9. <u>Exterior Walls and Trims:</u> The following materials are approved for the use in exterior walls and trims:

- a. Wood composite
- b. Aluminum, steel, fiber cement or vinyl siding products in an application approved by the
 - i. Architectural Review Committee.
 - ii. Stucco may be permitted as the primary or accent siding material. Colors shall be subject to approval.
- c. Brick
- d. Exterior color and material treatment used on the building walls shall be continuous and consistent on all elevations of the residence in order to achieve a uniform and complete architectural design.
- e. All colors are subject to approval by the Architectural Review Committee.

<u>Point of clarification:</u> In the event of vinyl siding replacement, the siding needs to be replaced in such a manner that results in a look that is consistent and intentional. Siding replacement that results in a mismatch of colors or siding profiles will <u>not</u> be approved. Dependent on weather and sun exposure, vinyl siding may fade or discolor over time, making it very difficult, if not impossible, to match.
